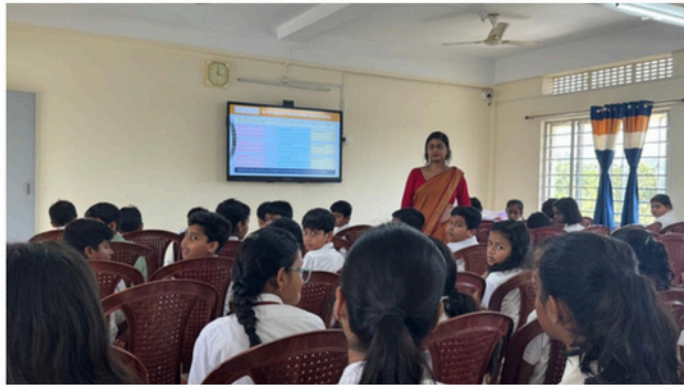


Emotional Development Workshops
